# SOVEREIGN EDICT OF THE MICROEMIRATE GESUITIC OF LATRUN ON THE RECOGNITION OF THE TIBETAN STATE AND OF THE TIBETAN GOVERNMENT IN EXILE

**Modena, Italia**

**9/3/2026**

We, the **Microemirate Gesuitic of Latrun**, a micronation of Italy, as a free expression of symbolic, cultural, spiritual, and artistic sovereignty, mindful of the dignity of peoples, the continuity of historical memory, the liberty of civilizations, and the primacy of the spirit over force, do hereby solemnly proclaim this Sovereign Edict.

Whereas Tibet stands in history as an ancient and singular civilization, endowed with its own spiritual inheritance, cultural authority, and national identity;

Whereas the Tibetan people, through exile, suffering, endurance, and fidelity, have preserved the living continuity of their religion, language, memory, and civilizational consciousness;

Whereas the Tibetan Government in Exile bears, in moral, historical, institutional, and spiritual continuity, the legitimate representation of the Tibetan nation and of its enduring aspirations;

Whereas the sovereign voice of a people is not extinguished by occupation, nor erased by coercion, but survives in prayer, in language, in memory, in art, and in the incorruptible fidelity of a nation to its own soul;

Whereas the founder and representative of the Microemirate recognizes a profound inner affinity with the spiritual tradition of Tibet and regards himself as a devoted follower of **Milarepa**, supreme witness of ascetic discipline, inward liberation, sacred song, and the unconquered freedom of the spirit;



Now therefore, in the name of truth, memory, justice, art, and spiritual sovereignty, the **Microemirate Gesuitic of Latrun** does hereby declare, affirm, and enact the following:

#### **Article I — Recognition of the Tibetan State**

The Microemirate Gesuitico di Latrun hereby recognizes the **Tibetan State** as a sovereign, independent, and living nation, and does so in symbolic, cultural, artistic, moral, and spiritual form, in affirmation of the historical, national, and spiritual reality of the Tibetan people.

#### **Article II — Recognition of the Tibetan Government in Exile**

The Microemirate Gesuitic of Latrun hereby recognizes the **Tibetan Government in Exile** as the **legitimate government of Tibet**, as custodian of the Tibetan nation's historical continuity, institutional legitimacy, cultural inheritance, and spiritual dignity.

#### **Article III — Spiritual Ground of this Recognition**

This act proceeds not only from historical conscience and cultural solidarity, but also from sincere reverence toward the spiritual wisdom of Tibet and toward the example of **Milarepa**, whose life remains a beacon of renunciation, transformation, poetic revelation, and invincible interior freedom.

#### **Article IV — Nature of this Act**

This recognition is issued as a sovereign symbolic, cultural, artistic, moral, and spiritual act, bearing witness to the enduring rights of peoples, to the unbroken dignity of civilizations, and to the principle that the soul of a nation transcends the contingencies of domination.

#### **Article V — Declaration of Solidarity**

By this Edict, the Microemirate Gesuitic of Latrun expresses its solemn and heartfelt solidarity with the Tibetan people, with their diaspora, with their monks, scholars, artists, witnesses, and representatives, and with all those who continue to preserve the living flame of Tibetan civilization.

#### **Article VI — Affirmation of Historical Dignity**

The Microemirate affirms that Tibet endures as a nation in the conscience of history and in the truth of its tradition, and that its sovereignty remains alive wherever its spirit, memory, faith, and culture remain unconquered.

#### **Article VII — Final Proclamation**

The Microemirate Gesuitic of Latrun declares its hope that the historical, religious, cultural, and political rights of Tibet shall one day receive full recognition in the conscience of nations and in the tribunal of future justice.

Let it therefore be known that, by this Sovereign Edict, the **Microemirate Gesuitic of Latrun, micronation of Italy**, raises its voice in honor of Tibet as a nation living in spirit, in history, and in truth.

Issued in solemn form, under the signs of art, memory, dignity, and the freedom of the spirit.
